



PROJECT PROFILE: FUEL TANK MANAGEMENT

Regulatory-compliant assessment and management of abandoned fuel storage assets in Nunavut.



BACKGROUND

Following the bankruptcy of a fuel distributor and contractor in Nunavut, the trustee was tasked with resolving the disposal of assets and liabilities associated with this company.

CORE was involved in numerous aspects of the project including inspecting the oil tanks, testing the fuel, data management and analyzing costs for the decommissioning of the site which included 36 tanks related to fuel storage systems.



DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Many of the tanks had been abandoned for several years and still contained product. CORE developed and implemented a comprehensive inspection program that leveraged local labour resources, supported by remote oversight from a certified tank engineer. Local personnel were trained and deployed to carry out fuel testing, tank dipping, sludge measurement, and tank locking and tagging, all under the direction of off-site CORE project managers to ensure consistency, safety, and regulatory compliance.

In addition, CORE supported the client by updating the FIRST Registry and preparing E2 Emergency Response Plans for the fuel tanks that remained in active service.
